SB1561 Legend

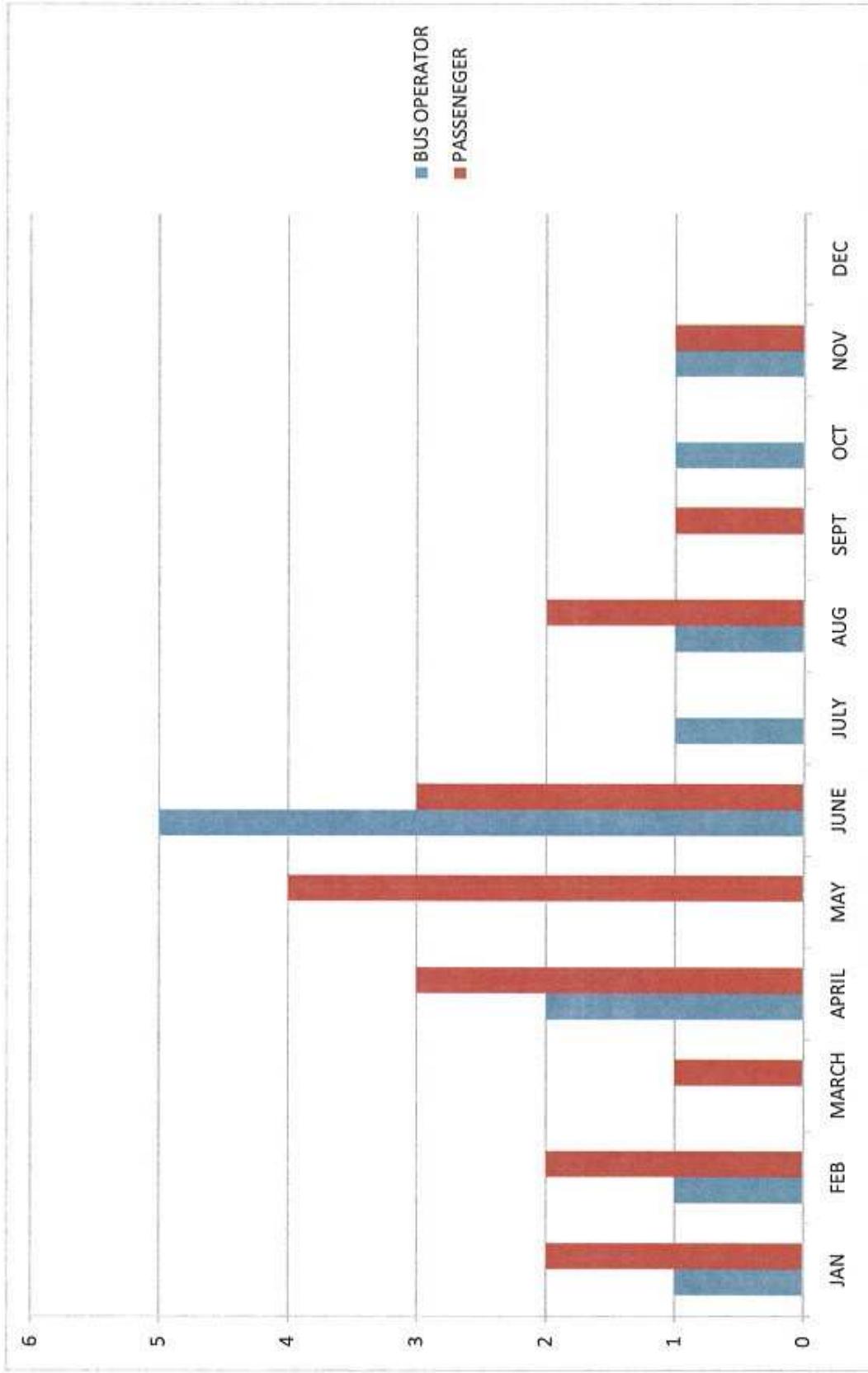
- 99170(a)(2) PUC: Interfere with the operator or operation of a transit vehicle, or impede the safe boarding or alighting of passengers.
 99170(a)(5) PUC: Commit any act or engage in any behavior that may, with reasonable foreseeability, cause harm or injury to any person or property.
 640(b)(6) PC: Willfully disturbing others on or in a system facility or vehicle by engaging in boisterous or unruly behavior.
 640(b)(7) PC: Carrying an explosive or acid, flammable liquid, or toxic or hazardous material in a public transit facility or vehicle.
 640(b)(8) PC: Urinating or defecating in a system facility or vehicle, except in a lavatory. However, this paragraph shall not apply to a person who cannot comply with this paragraph as a result of a disability, age, or a medical condition.
 640(b)(9)(A) PC - Willfully blocking the free movement of another person in a system facility or vehicle.
 640.5(a)(1) PC: Any person who defaces with graffiti or other inscribed material the interior or exterior of the facilities or vehicles.
 11532(a) H&S: It is unlawful for any person to loiter... intent to engage in drug-related activity.
 653.22 PC: (a) It is unlawful for any person to litter in any public place with the intent to commit prostitution.

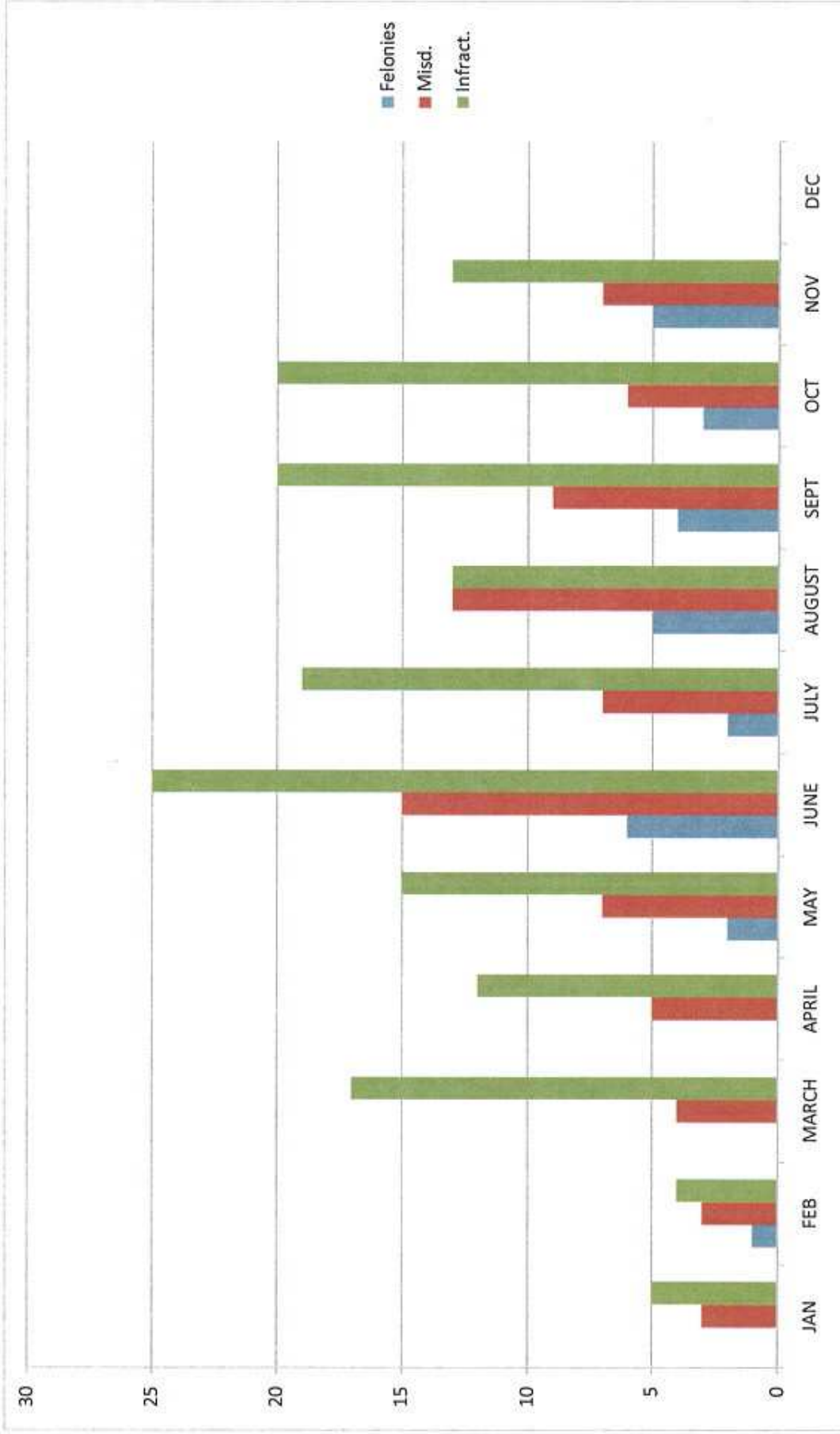
CHART of DRIVER and PASSENGER ASSAULTS/BATTERIES



This chart reflects the number of incidents that have occurred on FAX buses or bus stop where a bus operator or passenger was assaulted. An assault defined is the unlawful attempt to use force on another person. A battery is the unlawful use of force on another person. This chart does not differentiate between the two violations or the severity of injuries sustained if any.

Felony – Type of crime that is punishable by incarceration in a State facility.
 Misdemeanor – Type of crime that is punishable by incarceration in a County facility.
 Infraction – Type of violation that is normally punished with a fine.
